Representative Cases

- Defense verdict in a \$1.2 million medical malpractice claim against a local trauma hospital and emergency physician relating to an alleged failure to diagnose and treat a knee fracture.
- Co-defended an industrial laundry products distributor in a two-week product liability trial involving alleged asbestos exposure, resulting in a *de minimis*
- Obtained dismissal of a \$5 million timber trespass claim against a family farming business for alleged pesticide drift to adjacent property, including dismissal of double damages claim and attorney fees.
- Successfully argued motion to dismiss a multi-million dollar product liability claim against the subsidiary of a Fortune 100 chemical company based on statute of limitations.
- Successfully represented an agricultural cooperative in a \$2.8 million claim relating to alleged contamination of animal feed with botulism. Obtained partial summary judgment on implied warranty claims, resulting in favorable settlement of all claims.
